1. Age limit for Research Coordinator (Project Scientist) is 40 years and Senior Research Fellow (SRF) is 30 years as on the date of the interview. However, age relaxation the upper age limit may be relaxed up to 5 years in the case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC and Women applicants as per Government of Tamil Nadu norms.
2. Application should be in the prescribed format, duly signed and should be accompanied by self-attested copies of documents on educational qualifications, research experience, extracurricular activities, date of birth, mark sheets of all examinations, community certificate (if seeking relaxation as per Government of Tamil Nadu rules) etc.
3. The Forest Department will not provide accommodation and no TA/DA will be paid to the candidates appearing for the personal interview. The interview will be in either online or physical mode.
4. At the time of the verification of original documents or even after selection, if it is found that an attempt has been made by the applicant to wilfully conceal, misrepresent the facts or canvass, such application will be rejected, and due action will be taken against the candidate.


