ORDER:-

In the Government Order first read above, the State Board for Wildlife was constituted under Section 6 of Wildlife (Protection) Act 1972 (Principal Act) and under Section 7 of the Wildlife (Protection) Amendment Act 2002. The State Board for Wildlife shall advise the State Government on the following:-

- a) In the selection and management of areas to be declared as protected areas.
- b) In formulation of the policy for protection and conservation of the wildlife and specified plants.
- c) In any matter relating to the amendment of any schedule.
- d) In relation to the measures to be taken for harmonizing the needs of the tribal and other dwellers of the forests with the protection and conservation of wildlife, and
- e) In any other matter connected with the protection of wildlife which may be referred to it by the State Government.

2. In the Government Order second read above, the State Board for Wildlife was reconstituted. In the letter third read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden has requested the Government to reconstitute the State Board for Wildlife as the tenure of the non-official members have lapsed.
