ORDER:-

In the Government order first read above, among other things, the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.50.00 lakh for the capital works of Children's park at Guindy.

2. In the letter second read above, Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden has stated that Augmented Reality based show has been developed for public viewing in the Guindy Children's Park. This show is about 12 minutes in total, including animations of 10 amazing animals of World (Tiger, Chimpanzee, Giraffe, Dolphin, Penguin, Kangaroo, White Panda, Anaconda, Cheetah and Dinosaur). It differs from normal multi-dimensional view as in the Augmented Reality based show, the audience themselves are projected on screen and get a feel of interaction or touching the wildlife animations. The show is first of its kind in India though trials have been conducted in Mumbai and Kolkata. Hence, the above said show has been developed by existing infrastructure maintenance in Guindy Children's Park, Guindy at a cost of Rs.40.00 lakh sanctioned under capital works head in the above said Government order. The Guindy Children's Park, Guindy at present has entry fee of Rs.20.00 for adults and Rs.5.00 for children and annual expenditure for wages, maintenance, feed, etc., as exceeds the revenue at times and the annual maintenance of the show / equipments cannot be incurred with the current revenue of the park. Hence, the entry fee of Rs.20.00 and Rs.5.00 collected for adults and children's

respectively would cover the entry alone and cannot include the Augmented Reality show. Therefore, he has proposed for collection of fee for Augmented Reality based show on 10 Amazing animals of the world as follows:-

1.	Children (above 1 years to 14 years)	Rs.15.00
2.	Adult (above 14 years)	Rs.50.00

3. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden fix the rate of fee to be collected for Augmented reality show for public viewing as follows:-

1.	Children (above 1 years to 14 years)	Rs.15.00
2.	Adult (above 14 years)	Rs.50.00

The Government also direct that the income needs to be accounted for and future grant request shall include adjustments.
