Sub: Forests – Maximizing the Ground Water Recharge in Vanagaram Reserved Forest of Ariyalur Forest Division under Tamil Nadu Innovative and Initiative Fund for three years from 2016-17 to 2018-19 – Authorization requested for Rs.2.50 lakhs earmarked for the year 2018-19 – Requested - Regarding.

I am directed to state that in G.O.(D)No.39 Environment and Forests, (FR.7) Department, dated: 22.02.2017, the Government have issued orders for the scheme of "Maximizing the Ground Water Recharge in the Vanagaram Reserved Forest of Ariyalur Forest Division" for three years under TANII fund at a total cost of Rs.15.00 lakhs for the period from 2016-17 to 2018-19 with the sanction for the first year at the rate of Rs.10.00 lakh and the further two years at the rate of Rs.2.50 lakhs each for maintenance works.

2. In Government letter (D) No: 207, Environment and Forests (FR.7) Department, dated: 29.08.2017, the Government have issued authorization for the maintenance works on the scheme of "Maximizing the Ground Water Recharge in the Vanagaram Reserved Forest of Ariyalur Forest Division" for the second year viz 2017-18 at a cost of Rs.2.50 lakhs under TANII Fund as sanctioned in the Government Order first cited.

3. In the reference third cited, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has requested the Government to issue necessary authorization for an amount to the tune of Rs.2.50 lakhs, for the third year viz., 2018-19 for incurring the required amount sanctioned in the Government Order first cited for the maintenance works on the scheme of "Maximizing the Ground Water Recharge in the Vanagaram Reserved Forest of Ariyalur Forest Division" under TANII Fund. He has also informed that the works during 2016-17 and 2017-18 have been already carried out.

4. I am directed to convey the authorization of the Government to incur an expenditure of Rs.2.50 lakhs, (Rupees two lakh and fifty thousand only) for the maintenance works on the scheme of "Maximizing the Ground Water Recharge in the Vanagaram Reserve Forest of Ariyalur Forest Division" for the third year viz., 2018-19 as sanctioned in the Government Order first cited.

5. The expenditure authorized in para 3 above shall be debited in the following head of account:-

"4406 CAPITAL OUTLAY ON FORESTRY AND WILD LIFE - 01. Forestry-101 Forest Conservation, Development and Regeneration. State's Expenditure - JH Maximizing ground water recharge in Vanagaram Reserve Forest - Scheme under State Innovation Fund - 16 Major Works.

(DP Code. 4406 -01 -101 -JH - 1601)"

(ii) The expenditure shall be met from the State Innovation Fund by deducting under the following head of account:-

"4406 CAPITAL OTULAY ON FORESTRY AND WILD LIFE - 01. Forestry - 902 Deduct - Amount met from Reserve Fund. State's Expenditure. JA Deduct - Amount met from State Innovation Fund - 30 Inter - Account Transfers.

(DPC - 4406 - 01 - 902 - JA - 3007)"

And Contra - debiting the following fund account:-


"J - Reserve Fund - (b) Reserve funds not bearing interest - 8229 - 00 - Development Welfare Funds - 200. Other Development and Welfare Funds - BE State Innovation Fund

6. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above.
