ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued for the formation of the Tamil Nadu Forest Uniformed Services Recruitment Committee to select employees such as Forester, Forest Guard, Forest Guard with Driving Licence and Forest Watcher in the Forest Department by direct recruitment.

2. In the letter second read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has stated that the Tamil Nadu Forest Uniformed Services Recruitment Committee was entrusted with the task of recruiting 227 Forest Guard through direct recruitment and it is expected that 1,00,000 candidates may appear for the examination. Thus, for 1,00,000 candidates, the expenditure will amount to Rs.1.77 Crores (@ Rs.177/- per candidate excluding service charges and GST) and the budget requirement/ Financial forecast for the year 2019-2020 is summarized below:-

3. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has therefore requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.2,39,10,000/- for conducting online examination for the recruitment of Forest Watcher through direct recruitment by Tamil Nadu Forest Uniformed Services Recruitment Committee.

4. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, and sanction a sum of Rs.2,34,09,000/- (Rupees Two crore thirty four lakh and nine thousand only) for conducting online examination for the recruitment of 227 Forest Guard through direct recruitment by Tamil Nadu Forest Uniformed Services Recruitment Committee.

5. A sum of Rs.2,34,09,000/- shall be debited into the following head of account:-

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.2,34,09,000/- will be provided in Revised Estimates / Final Modified Appropriation 2019-2020 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoD) is authorized to incur the above expenditure. However, the above expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by a Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2019-2020. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is also directed to include the expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above while sending the budget proposals for Revised Estimates / Final Modified Appropriation 2019-2020 and also to send draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in Supplementary Estimates 2019-20 to Finance (AHD&F/BG.I) Department at an appropriate time without fail.
