**ORDER :**

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have accorded administrative approval for a sum of Rs.50.00 lakh for “Greening of Dindigul Malaikottai using special planting techniques” over a period of three years from 2017-2018 to 2019-2020 as detailed below and released a sum of Rs.22.35 lakh for the year 2017-2018:

2. In the Government Order second read above, the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.14.10 lakh under the scheme to carry out the planting and maintenance works, during the year 2018-2019.

3. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in his letter third read above has stated that under the above scheme, an amount of Rs.22.35 lakh and Rs.14.10 lakh were released during 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 by the Government, respectively. Based on the sanction accorded to implement the scheme during 2018-2019 at a total cost of Rs.14.10 lakh, the works have been carried out without any shortfall. The Chief Conservator of Forests, Dindigul has also informed that out of 2250 Nos. of seedlings planted during 2017-2018, there is a survival of 2030 Nos. of seedlings and therefore, the second year maintenance has been proposed for 2030 Nos of seedlings. The details of works proposed to be carried out during 2019-2020 are as follows:-

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has therefore requested the Government to accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.13.55 lakh to carry out the works mentioned above, during the year 2019-2020, under the scheme.

4. The Government have carefully examined the request of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and sanction a sum of Rs.13.55 lakh (Rupees Thirteen lakh and Fifty five thousand only) to carry out the nursery and maintenance works as proposed in para 3 above for "Greening the Dindigul Malaikottai Hill using special planting techniques", during the year 2019-2020.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-
