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**ORDER:**

In the letters second read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.477.23 lakhs for the following items of works proposed under Forest Protection Scheme for the year 2018-2019 :-

The break-up details for the various items of works proposed under Forest Protection Scheme are annexed to this order.

2. The Government, after careful examination, accept the proposal by restricting the overall sanction Rs.423.72 lakhs (Rupees Four Crores twenty three lakhs and seventy two thousand only) for implementation of Forest Protection Scheme for the year 2018-2019 by taking the works as detailed in the Annexure to this order.

3. The expenditure sanctioned in para 2 above shall be debited under the following head of account:-

"4406 – CAPITAL OUTLAY ON FORESTRY AND WILDLIFE – 01 –  
Forestry – 800 Other Expenditure. State's Expenditure. JA – Forest  
Protection – 416 Major works 01- Major works.

(DPC 4406 01 800 JA 41601)"

4. Necessary additional funds of Rs.423.72 lakhs will be provided in Revised Estimates / Final Modified Appropriation 2019-2020 to meet the expenditure sanctioned/released in para 2 above. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to incur the expenditure. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2019-2020. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is also directed to include the expenditure sanctioned above, while sending the budget proposals for Revised Estimates/ Final Modified Appropriation 2019-2020 to Finance (AHD&F/BG.I) Department at an appropriate time without fail.

5. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests shall ensure that the amount sanctioned is utilized in full during the year 2019-2020 and to send utilization certificate to Government as soon as the works are completed.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide it's U.O.15530, Finance (AH&F) Department dated: 31.05.2019 and ASL No. 354 (Three hundred and fifty four)


