ORDER:

In Government Order first read above, the Government have accorded administrative sanction to the Project on rejuvenation of Palar River for a period of two years from 2020-2021 to 2021-2022 at a total cost of Rs.1302.07 lakh with the loan assistance of Rs.882.15 lakh from NABARD and the balance amount of Rs.419.92 lakh from State Fund as follows:-

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2. The Deputy General Manager, NABARD in the letter second read above has informed that out of total outlay of Rs.1302.07 lakhs the loan was sanctioned by NABARD for a sum of Rs.882.15 Lakh to implement the project "Infrastructure works related to harvesting of rain water in degraded Forest area in the catchment zone and thereby leading to rejuvenation of Palar River under Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF-XXV) 2019-2020. The NABARD loan amount for the year 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 are Rs.529.29 lakh and Rs.352.86 lakh respectively.

3. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in his letter third read above has requested for revised administrative sanction order for implementation of the project on rejuvenation of Palar River in Kancheepuram District during the period from 2019-2020 to 2020-2021 instead of 2020-2021 to 2021-2022 along with financial sanction for authorizing to draw and disburse the funds to the tune of Rs.626.41 lakhs to implement the scheme during 2019-2020.

4. The Government after careful consideration have decided to accept the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests. Accordingly the Government direct that the duration of implementation of the project on rejuvenation of Palar River in Kancheepuram district be revised as 2019-2020 to 2020-2021 instead of 2020-2021 to 2021-2022. The Government sanction a sum of Rs.626.41 lakh (Rupees Six crore twenty six lakh and forty one thousand only) which includes NABARD loan amount of Rs.529.29 lakh and State fund Rs.97.12 lakh to carry out the above said project, as detailed in the cost table annexed to this order during 2019-2020.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

4406 – Capital outlay on Forestry and Wild Life – 01. Forestry – 800.
Other Expenditure State's Expenditure – JZ – Implementation of schemes
in Forest Department with Loan Assistance from NABARD – 416 Major
works – 01 Major works.

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.626.41 lakh will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2019-2020. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to incur the expenditure, sanctioned in para 4 above. He is also directed to include the above item of expenditure while sending budget proposal of Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2019-2020 to Finance (AH,D&F) Department at an appropriate time without fail.

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7. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is requested to ensure that the amount sanctioned for the above work is utilized during the financial year 2019-2020 and to send the utilization certificate to Government as soon as the work is completed.

8. This orders issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide U.O. No. 47917/AHD&F/2019, Dated 30.09.2019 and ASL No. 1578 (One thousand five hundred and seventy eight)
