ORDER :

In the Government order first read above, the Government have accorded administrative approval for implementing the scheme of “Enrichment of Non-Timber Forest Products Resources in Forest areas of Tamil Nadu” at a total cost of Rs.314.71 lakh for a period of 7 years from 2017-2018 to 2023-2024 as detailed below and released a sum of Rs.56.64 lakh for implementation of the scheme during the year 2017-2018:-

2. In the Government Order second read above, an amount of Rs.69.83 lakh was released for implementation of the scheme for the year 2018-2019.

3. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in his letter third read above, has stated that out of the sanctioned amount of Rs. 56.64 lakh sanctioned in the Government Order first read above, the works were carried out to the tune of Rs. 51.96 lakh leaving an unspent balance of Rs. 4.68 lakh during the year 2017-2018. He has further stated that out of Rs. 69.83 lakh sanctioned in the Government Order second read above, Rs. 67.34 lakh has been spent leaving an unspent balance of Rs.2.49 lakh.

4. He has therefore requested the Government to issue necessary authorization for utilizing the unspent amount as detailed below and also requested to release the amount for the year 2019-2020:-
