ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.367.80 lakhs towards implementation of the Forest Research Scheme for the year 2019-2020. In the letter second read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has been requested to send proposal for some research project on propagation of Red list tree of Tamil Nadu for effective utilization of balance Research funding provided in the Budget 2019-2020.

2. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has stated that the following eight important red list trees chosen based on logistic and availability of species. Based on it, five to six will be taken for the clinical investigation and propagation.

1. Hydnocarpus macrocarpa
2. Artocarpus hirsutus
3. Canarium strictum
4. Garcinia spicata
5. Justicia beddomei
6. Phyllanthus indofischeri
7. Hildegardia populifolia
8. Nothapodytes nimmoniana

He has also stated that the proposed project requires a minimum of two years to research, plan and execution and there will be an essential requirement of continuity of the financial assistance for second year, i.e., 2020-2021 also. He has therefore requested to sanction a sum of Rs.30.00 Lakh (Rupees Thirty lakhs only) for current year i.e., 2019-2020 for the clinical investigation and carryout the following activities for propagation of Red list Tree species:-

The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, sanction a sum of Rs.5.00 lakhs (Rupees Five lakhs only) for the propagation of Red List Trees of Tamil Nadu for raising nursery and it's maintenance during 2019-2020 under Forest Research activities.
