The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has sent a detailed project proposal for rejuvenation of Palar River in Kancheepuram District, to the tune of Rs.1302.07 Lakhs with the funding assistance from NABARD for a period two years to carry out the activities of soil and moisture conservation, improvement of vegetation etc.

The General Managar, NABARD in the letter second read above has informed that Internal sanctioning Committee held on 14.06.2019 has sanctioned an amount of Rs.882.15 Lakh as RIDF loan out of total financial outlay Rs.1302.07 Lakh to Government of Tamil Nadu, for the project of rejuvenation of Palar River with infrastructure works related to harvesting of rain water in the degraded forest area of catchment zone of the said river, for the year 2020-21 to 2021-2022 under RIDF XXV. issue for necessary administrative sanction order for the above project on or before 23.07.2019 so as to issue detailed sanction letter. The State Government fund for the above said scheme is Rs.419.92 Lakhs which includes ineligible cost Rs.373.49 Lakh of the total project cost of Rs.1302.07 Lakhs.

3. The Government, after careful examination, accord administrative sanction to the project on "Rejuvenation of Palar River in Kancheepuram District" for a period of two years from 2020-21 to 2021-22 at a total cost of Rs.1302.07 Lakhs (Rupees One thousand three hundred and two lakh and seven thousand only) with the loan assistance of Rs.882.15 Lakhs from NABARD and Rs.419.92 Lakhs will be met out from the State fund as detailed below:-
