ORDER:-

In the letter 1st read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has stated that the proposal for preparation of an atlas of the birds of Virudhunagar District has been placed before the State Planning Commission for sanctioning a sum of Rs.25.00 lakh under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) – State Innovation fund for the year 2019-2020 (Round II) in order to reach the following objectives:-

1. To make a checklist of the birds found in Virudhunagar district.
2. To demarcate the distribution of each bird species, represented by a map of the District showing where they are seen and how abundant they are.
3. To assess the population fluctuation across two seasons.
4. To provide general information of the area and its bird diversity for future studies.

2. In the letter 2nd read above, the State Planning Commission has recommended the above project at a cost of Rs.25.00 lakh for a period of one year under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) 2019-2020 (Round II). Therefore, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has requested to sanction a sum of Rs.25.00 lakh for preparation of an atlas of the birds of Virudhunagar District under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) – State Innovation Fund for the year 2019-2020 (Round II).

3. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests accord administrative approval and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.25.00 lakh (Rupees Twenty five lakh) for preparation of an atlas of the birds of Virudhunagar District under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) – State Innovation Fund for the year 2019-2020 (Round II) as annexed to this order.

4. (i) The expenditure sanctioned in para-3 above shall be debited to the following new head of account opened under Demand No.54.01:-

5. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is the Estimating, Reconciling and Controlling authority of the above new head of account.

7. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to draw and disburse the amount released in para-3 above. He is also requested to ensure that the amount released therein is utilized in full and to send the utilization certificate as soon as the work is completed.
