ORDER:-

In the Government order first read above, the Government have sanctioned administrative approval for a sum of Rs.44.00 lakhs for two years from 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 and released a sum of Rs.46.90 lakhs for the year 2018-2019 for establishment of an "Orchidarium" in Anamalai Tiger Reserve.

2. Now, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden in his letter second read above has stated that the Orchidarium has been implemented in full during 2018-2019 by utilizing the amount of Rs.44.00 lakh sanctioned in the above said Government order and furnished the progress report and Utilisation Certificate for the amount sanctioned during 2018-19, as on 31.03.2019. Therefore, he has requested the Government to release the balance amount allocated for the year 2019-2020 as per the administrative approval for the above purpose.

3. The Government after careful consideration accept the request of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden and release a sum of Rs.2.90 lakhs (Rupees two lakhs and ninety thousand only) for maintenance of the Orchidarium in Anamalai Tiger Reserve for the year 2019-2020.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-
