ORDER:-

In the Government order first read above, the Government have accorded administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.17.87 lakh and released a sum of Rs.10.78 lakh for long term monitoring of Montane grasslands including establishment of field research station at Grass-hills area of the Anamalai Tiger Reserve, Tamil Nadu.

2. In the letter second read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has requested to release the balance sum of Rs.7.09 lakh for establishment of field research station at Grass-hills area of the Anamalai Tiger Reserve for the year 2019-2020 under TANII - State Innovation Fund.

3. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden and sanction a sum of Rs.7.09 lakh (Rupees Seven lakh and nine thousand only) for long term monitoring of montane grasslands including establishment of field research station at Grass-hills area of the Anamalai Tiger Reserve, Tamil Nadu during 2019-2020 under TANII - State Innovation Fund.

4. (i) The expenditure sanctioned in para-4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

(ii). The expenditure shall be met from the State Innovation Fund by deducting under the following head of account:-

And Contra – debiting the following fund account :-

"J- Reserve Fund – (b) Reserve funds not bearing interest - 8229 – 00 – Development Welfare Funds – 200. Other Development and Welfare Funds – BE State Innovation Fund

5. Necessary funds are available under Budget Estimates 2019-2020 in the above head of account. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para-3 above. He is also requested to ensure that the amount released therein is utilized in full and to send the utilization certificate as soon as the work is completed.
