ORDER :

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have accorded administrative approval for Restoration of the Tropical Dry Evergreen Forests (TDEF) in Nanmangalam Reserved Forests, Chennai at a cost of Rs.120.00 lakh over a period of three years as detailed below and also sanctioned a sum of Rs.57.53 lakh for implementation of the above scheme during the year 2016-2017 :-

2. In the Government Letters second and third read above, the Government have authorized the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests to incur an expenditure of Rs.55.53 lakh pertaining to the year 2016-2017 for utilizing during 2017-2018, and Rs.9.51 lakh pertaining to the year 2016-2017 for utilizing the same during 2018-2019 respectively, under the above scheme.

3. In the Government Order fourth read above a sum of Rs.49.97 lakh pertaining to the year 2017-2018 has been sanctioned during the year 2018-2019 for implementing the works, under the above scheme.

4. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in his letter fifth read above has stated that an amount of Rs.12.50 lakh pertaining to the year 2018-2019 was not released as the works pertaining to 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 had to be completed during 2018-2019. He has therefore, requested the Government to release a sum of Rs.12.50 lakh during 2019-2020, to carry out the following works under the said scheme:-

5. The Government after careful consideration of the request of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, sanction a sum of Rs.12.50 lakh (Rupees Twelve Lakh and Fifty Thousand only) pertaining to the year 2018-2019 towards the implementation of the scheme of Restoration of the Tropical Dry Evergreen Forests (TDEF) in Nanmangalam Reserved Forests, Chennai, during the year 2019-2020.

6. (i) The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account :-

“2406 FORESTRY AND WILD LIFE – 01. Forestry – 101 Forest Conservation, Development and Regeneration. State’s Expenditure - JC. Restoration of the Tropical Dry Evergreen Forest in Nanmangalam Reserved Forest – under State Innovation Fund – 309 Grants-in-Aid. 03 Grants for Specific Schemes

(DPC – 2406 01 101 JC 0937)

(ii) The expenditure shall be met from the State Innovation Fund by deducting under the following head of account :-

“2406 FORESTRY AND WILD LIFE – 01. Forestry – 902 Deduct – Amount met from Reserve Fund. State’s Expenditure - JA Deduct – Amount met from State Innovation Fund – 330 Inter-Account Transfers – 01 – Inter – Account - Transfer

And Contra-debiting the following fund account :-

“J- Reserve Fund – (b) Reserve funds not bearing interest – 8229- 00 – Development Welfare Funds – 200. Other Development and Welfare Funds –BE State Innovation Fund

7. Necessary additional funds of Rs.12.50 lakh will be provided in Revised Estimates/Final Modified Appropriation 2019-2020 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to incur the expenditure. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is requested to send necessary proposals to Government in Finance (AHD&F) Department for inclusion of the above amount in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2019-2020 at an appropriate time without fail.
