### ORDER:-

In the Government Order read above Government have accorded financial sanction for a sum of Rs.700 lakh for Tribal Eco Cultural Village Sathyamangalam Tiger Reserve in Erode under State Innovation Fund during the year 2018-2019.

2. In the letter second read above the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has sent a revalidation proposal for sanctioning the unspent amount of Rs.312.61 lakh in order to complete the remaining works for the establishment of "Tribal Eco Cultural Village – A living museum in Sathyamangalam Division, Sathyamangalam Tiger Reserve, Erode" during 2019-2020.

3. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden revalidate a sum of Rs.312.61 lakh (Rupees Three Hundred and twelve lakh and Sixty One Thousand Only) for Tribal Eco Cultural Village Sathyamangalam Tiger Reserve in Erode under State Innovation Fund during the year 2019-2020.

5. Necessary additional funds of Rs.312.61 lakh will be provided in Revised Estimates / Final Modified Appropriation 2019-2020 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden is authorized to incur the expenditure. However, the above expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by a Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2019-2020. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden also directed to include the expenditure, while sending the budget proposals for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2019-2020 and also send draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2019-2020 to Finance (AHD&BG.I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

6. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para-3 above. He is also requested to ensure that the amount released therein is utilized in full and to send the utilization certificate as soon as the work is completed.
