ORDER :

In Government Order first read above, the Government have accorded administrative approval for "Raising Palmyra Palm Plantation in Government and Community Lands in Tamil Nadu", at a cost of Rs.138.14 lakhs for a period of five years from 2016-2017 to 2020-2021 and also sanctioned a sum of Rs.25.00 lakhs towards implementation of the above scheme during 2016-2017.

2. In the Government letter second read above, the Government authorized the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests to incur an expenditure of Rs.1.943 lakhs, being the unspent balance of the year 2016-2017, for utilizing during 2017-2018, under the above scheme.

3. In Government Order third read above, the Government have accorded financial sanction for a sum of Rs.26.25 lakhs towards the implementation of the above scheme during the year 2017-2018.

4. In Government order fourth read above, the Government have accorded financial sanction for a sum of Rs.27.56 lakhs towards the implementation of the above scheme during the year 2018-2019.

5. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in his letter fifth read above, has stated that during 2018-2019 the works towards the implementation of the scheme of "Raising Palmyra Palm Plantation in Government and Community Lands in Tamil Nadu" were carried out and a sum of Rs.27.56 lakhs was utilized fully, pertaining to the year 2018-2019. He has therefore requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.28.94 lakhs, towards the implementation of the above scheme, for the year 2019-2020.

5. The Government have carefully examined the above proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in detail and sanctioned a sum of Rs.28.94 lakhs (Rupees Twenty eight lakh and ninety four thousand only) for the implementation of the scheme of "Raising Palmyrah Palm Plantation in Government and Community Lands in Tamil Nadu" during the year 2020-2021.

6. The expenditure authorized in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

Forestry-105 Forest Produce -- State's Expenditure - JF

7. Necessary additional funds Rs.28.94 lakh will be provided in Revised Estimates/Final Modified Appropriation 2020-2021 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to incur the expenditure.

However, the above expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislative Assembly by specific inclusion in Supplementary Estimate 2020-2021. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is also directed to send necessary proposal for inclusion of this expenditure in RE / FMA 2020-2021 and also send necessary draft explanatory note for specific inclusion in the supplementary estimate 2020-21 to Finance (AHD&F/BG.I) Department at an appropriate time without fail.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No 27303/AHD&F/2020, Dated: 21.09.2020 and ASL No.554 (Five hundred and fifty four).
