ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above orders have been issued sanctioning an amount of Rs.22.00 lakhs for providing assured drinking water facilities to the tribal settlements in Tirunelveli, Vellore, Salem & Villupuram Districts, for the year 2019-2020.

2. Now the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has stated that many tribal settlements do not have safe drinking water facility and protected drinking water is one of the basic needs of the tribal people and this facility has to be provided to the four remote tribal settlements of Dharmapuri, Vellore, Salem and Villupuram Districts. It includes providing bore well, water storage tank & pipeline for water distribution for the year 2020-2021, at a cost of Rs.22.000 lakhs as follows:-

3. Further, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has stated that Rs.22.00 lakhs has been allocated in Budget Estimate 2020-2021 for providing assured drinking water facilities to the tribal settlements and also requested orders sanctioning the scheme during the year 2020-2021.

4. The Government, after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and sanction a sum of Rs.22.00 lakh (Rupees Twenty two lakh only) for providing assured drinking water facilities to the four tribal settlements as mentioned in para-2 above for the year 2020-2021.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account :-

"2225 Welfare of Scheduled Caste scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and Minorities – 02 Welfare of Scheduled Tribes – 796 Tribal Area Sub-Plan State's Expenditure JW – Providing assured and safe drinking water to Tribal Areas – 317 Minor Works – 01 Minor Works.
