



## **ABSTRACT**

Forests – Eco-Restoration of Nanmangalam Reserved Forest area of 18 Hectare - Administrative approval accorded for Rs.250.00 lakhs for a period of five years from 2018-2019 to 2022-2023 – Release of a sum of Rs.37.43 lakh for the year 2020-2021 - towards first year maintenance of seedlings raised and planted during the year 2018-2019 & 2019-2020- - Sanction - Orders – Issued.

### **ORDER :**

In Government order first read above, the Government accorded administrative sanction of a sum of Rs.2.50 crore for implementing the scheme Eco-restoration works in Nanmangalam Reserved Forest area of 18 Hectare out of 320 Hectare, by undertaking high density planting for improving Biodiversity and for creating green lungs in and around Chennai over a period of five years from 2018-2019 to 2022-2023 as detailed below and also released a sum of Rs.80.74 lakhs for the year 2018-2019 towards the raising of seedlings :-

3. Subsequently, in the Government Order second read above, orders have been issued to release a sum of Rs.97.68 lakh for planting of taller and smaller seedlings raised under the scheme of Eco restoration of Nanmangalam Reserved Forests area of 18 Hectare, during the year 2019-2020.

4. Now, the PCCF in his letter third read above has sent a proposal seeking necessary orders of the Government to release a sum of Rs.37.43 lakh for the year 2020-2021 towards the first year maintenance of the seedlings raised and planted during the years 2018-2019 & 2019-2020, under the scheme Eco-Restoration of Nanmangalam Reserve Forest area of 18 Hectare as detailed below:-

5. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has therefore requested the Government to release a sum of Rs. 37.43 lakhs for the year 2020-21 towards the first year maintenance of the seedlings raised and planted during the years 2018-19 and 2019-20 under the scheme Eco-Restoration of Nanmangalam Reserve forest area of 18 Hectare.

6. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests have decided to accept and release a sum of Rs. 37.43 lakhs (Thirty seven lakhs and forty three thousands only) towards the first year maintenance of the seedlings raised and planted during the years 2018-19 and 2019-20 under the scheme Eco-Restoration of Nanmangalam Reserve forest area of 18 Hectare for the year 2020-21.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-
