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ORDER :

The Hon'ble Chief Minister has made the following Announcement on the floor of Legislative Assembly on 05.07.2019 under Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rule 110:-

“வனப்பகுதியில் உள்ள வனச்சாலைகளை பராமரித்து மேம்படுத்த வரும் ஆண்டுகளில் 200 கோடி ரூபாய் செலவிட உத்தேசிக்கப்பட்டுள்ள நிலையில், நடப்பாண்டில் 577 கி.மீ. நீளமுள்ள வனச்சாலைகளை மேம்படுத்தி 57.70 கோடி ரூபாய் மதிப்பீட்டில் பராமரிப்பு பணிகள் மேற்கொள்ளப்படும்.”

2. In the Government Order 1st read above, the Government have accorded administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.57.70 Crore for the improvement and maintenance of 107 forests roads at length of 576.972 km for the year 2019-2020.

3. In the Government Order 2nd read above, the Government have accorded financial sanction for a sum of Rs.5752.56 Lakh for the improvement and maintenance of 107 forest roads at a length of 576.972 km in Trichy and Harur Forest Engineering Division.

4. In the letter 3rd read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has requested administrative and financial sanction for the balance amount of Rs.14247.440 Lakh out of Rs.200 Crore in order to implement the said works during 2020-2021 and complete the works within the financial year without any further revalidation.

5. In the reference 4th read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has been informed that in view of COVID 19 and the highly constrained fiscal situation the Government has restricted the sanction to Rs.20.00 Crore for the maintenance / improvement in Forest roads during the year 2020-2021 and requested to furnish the list of forest roads on priority of the works.

6. In the reference 5th read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has furnished the list of forest roads proposed and the abstract with component wise, cost wise road details and requested administrative and financial sanction for an amount of Rs.20.00 Crore (Rupees Twenty Crore only) for the improvement/ maintenance of the 18 forest roads at the length of 89.00 Kms during 2020-2021.

7. The Government after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests at para 6 above and accord administrative and financial sanction for an amount of Rs.20,00,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Crore only) for the improvement/ maintenance of the 18 forest roads at the length of 89.00 Kms during 2020-2021, as per the list annexed to this order.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above shall be debited under the following head of account:-

"3054 ROADS AND BRIDGES - 04 District and other Roads 337 Road works - State's Expenditure - AK Maintenance and Improvements of Roads in Forest Area -318 Maintenance -01 Periodical Maintenance"
(Old DPC: 3054 04 337 AK 18 15)
(IFHRMS DPC: 3054 04 337 AK 318 01)

9. Necessary additional funds of Rs.10,02,29,000/- will be provided in RE/FMA, 2020-2021. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to draw and utilize the amount sanctioned in para-7 above. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2020-2021. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is directed to include this item of expenditure while sending the proposal for RE/FMA 2020-2021 and also send draft explanatory note for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate to Government in Finance (AHD&F/BG-1) Department without fail.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O No.42345/Fin(AHD&F)/2020, dated: 23.11.2020 and Additional Sanction Ledger No. 933 (Nine Hundred and Thirty three).
