In the Government order cited, the Government have sanctioned a sum of  
Rs.2,50,00,000 (Rupees Two crore and fifty lakh only) for the maintenance of Advanced  
Institute for Wildlife Conservation for the year 2019-2020. Out of the above, an amount  
of Rs.1,35,00,000/- was sanctioned under recurring cost.

2. In the circumstances stated in the letter second cited, I am directed to  
authorize the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden to incur  
an amount of Rs.1,19,35,075/- (Rupees One Crore Nineteen lakh thirty five thousand  
and seventy five only) out of Rs.250.00 lakh which was originally sanctioned in  
Government Order first cited during the year 2019-2020, for recurring expenditure only  
for maintenance of Advanced Institute for Wildlife Conservation under the following  
head of account :-

4406 – Capital Outlay on Forestry and Wildlife – 02 Environmental  
Forestry and Wildlife – 111 Zoological Park – State's Expenditure  
– JI Establishment of Advanced Institute for Wildlife Conservation  
at Arignar Anna Zoological Park, Vandalur – 416 Major Works -  
01 Major Works.

3. Necessary funds of Rs.1,19,35,075/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2020-2021. Pending provision of such funds RE/FMA 2020-21, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Chief Wildlife Warden is authorized to draw and utilize the amount sanctioned in para 2 above. However this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by a Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2020-2021. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is also directed to include this expenditure, while sending the proposals for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2020-2021 and also send draft explanatory notes for including in Supplementary Estimates to Government in Finance (AHD&F / BG.I) Department without fail.
