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ORDER :

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have accorded administrative approval for a sum of Rs.2087.07 lakhs for implementing the scheme of Creation of Fodder Resources inside Reserve Forests to mitigate human animal conflict over a period of five years from 2011-2012 to 2015-2016 as detailed below :-

and also accorded financial sanction for an amount of Rs.345.88 lakhs to undertake the works during the year 2011-2012. Further the Government released the sanctioned amount in the subsequent years from 2012-2013 to 2016-2017 under the said scheme.

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2. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Chief Wildlife Warden in his letter second read above has sent a proposal to implement the scheme of Creation of Fodder Resources inside Reserve Forests to mitigate human animal conflict for a total outlay of Rs.400.00 lakhs during the year 2019-2020. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Chief Wildlife Warden has therefore requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.400.00 lakhs to implement the above scheme during the year 2019-2020.

3. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Chief Wildlife Warden in detail and sanction a sum of Rs.4,00,00,000/- (Rupees Four Crores only) for implementing the scheme of "Creation of Fodder Resources and improvement of wildlife habitat inside the forest areas during the year 2020-2021.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account :- (D.No.54-01)

4406 - Capital Outlay on Forestry and Wild Life - 02 Environmental Forestry and Wild Life - 110 Wildlife - State's Expenditure - JN Creation of Fodder Tree Plantations in Forest Areas and to improve the Wildlife habitats - 416 Major Works - 01 - Major Works.

5. Necessary additional funds of Rs.4,00,00,000/- (Rupees Four Crores only) will be provided in RE/FMA 2020-2021. Pending provision of such funds in RE/FMA 2020-2021, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above.

However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2020-2021. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is directed to include this item of expenditure while sending the proposal for RE/FMA 2020-2021 and also send draft explanatory note for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate to Government in Finance (AHD&F / BG-I) Department without fail.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide it's U.O.No.17207/AHD&F/2020, dated 03.07.2020 with Additional Sanction Ledger No.182 (One Hundred and Eighty Two).
