ORDER:

In Government Order first read above, administrative sanction was accorded for a sum of Rs.39.00 lakhs for implementation of the scheme "**Generation of molecular makers in Terminalia chebula for genetic and phytochemical marker assisted selection of elite clone**" scheme to be implemented over a period of two years under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives Fund and released a sum of Rs.33.00 lakhs during the year 2018-2019.

2. In Government Order second read above, a sum of Rs.38.56 lakhs (i.e. release of fund Rs.6.00 lakhs pertaining to 2019-20 and permission to utilize the unspent balance of Rs.32.56 lakhs pertaining to the year 2018-2019) was sanctioned.

3. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in his letter third read above, has sent a proposal for revalidation of the unspent amount along with the Utilization Certificate. In Government letter dated 21.07.2020, the proposal was deferred and the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has been requested to re-submit the proposal after normalization of financial position of the State.

4. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Department), Chennai in his letter fourth read above, has resubmitted the revalidation proposal for implementation of "Generation of Molecular makers in Terminalia Chebula for genetic and phytochemical marker assisted selection of elite clone" scheme during 2021-2022 to the tune of Rs.9.89 lakhs (Rs.3.89 lakhs pertaining to 2018-2019 and Rs.6.00 lakhs pertaining to 2019-2020) to Government along with the present status of the scheme furnished by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Research). The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Department) in his letter dated 08.09.2021 has furnished the component wise requirement to carry out the pending works during 2021-22 as below:-

5. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has therefore requested to release an amount of Rs.9.89 lakhs during the year 2021-2022.

6. The Government after careful examination of the proposal, release a sum of Rs.9,89,000/- (Rupees Nine lakh and eighty nine thousand only) for implementation of the scheme "**Generation of molecular makers in Terminalia chebula for genetic and phytochemical marker assisted selection of elite clone**" during the year 2021-2022.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“2415 Agricultural Research and Education – 06 Forestry – 004 Research – State’s Expenditure – JJ – Generation of molecular makers in Terminalia Chebula and selection of Elite clones under State Innovation Fund – 309 Grants in aid – 03 Grants for specific schemes. (IFHRMS DPC: 2415-06-004-JJ-30903) ”

The expenditure shall be met from the State Innovation Fund by deducting under the following head of account:-

“2415 Agricultural Research and Education – 06 Forestry – 902 Deduct – Amount met from State Innovation Fund - State’s Expenditure – JA Deduct - Amount met from State Innovation Fund – 330 Inter-Account Transfers – 01 Inter-Account Transfers. (IFHRMS DPC: 2415-06-902-JA-33001) ”

And Contra-debiting the following fund account:-

“J – Reserve fund - (b) Reserve funds not bearing interest – 8229-00 Development Welfare funds – 200. Other Development and Welfare funds – BE – State Innovation Fund – 802 – Outgo – 02 – Non Bearing Interest. (IFHRMS DPC: 8229-00-200-BE 80202) – Outgo”

8. Necessary additional funds of Rs.9,89,000/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2021-2022. Pending provision of such funds, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 6 above. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is also directed to include this item of expenditure while sending the proposal for RE/FMA 2021-2022 to Government in Finance (AHD&F) Department without fail.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.52794/AHD&F/2021, Finance (AHD&F) Department, dated: 22.12.2021 with Additional Sanction Ledger No.1224 (One thousand two hundred and twenty four).
