The positions are purely temporary and on contractual basis.

Educational Qualification, Experience and Remuneration

Nature of Appointment

The engagement to the post of **Green Fellow** is purely **temporary and contractual** in nature and shall not confer any right whatsoever for **regular appointment** in the Tamil Nadu Forest Department.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS


1. The age limit for engagement to the post of Green Fellow shall be as prescribed in Annexure-I. Age relaxation shall be applicable as per the existing rules and orders of the Government of Tamil Nadu.
2. Green Fellows engaged for this work shall be those selected by the Department of Environment (DoE) through the prescribed selection process, deployed at the district level under the administrative control of the respective District Collectors, and trained by Anna University, the designated knowledge partner.
3. Candidates shortlisted for interview shall be required to appear in person before the Selection Committee at the State Forest Research Institute, Kolappakkam, Chennai – 600 127, on the date and time notified, along with the original application and all supporting documents for verification.
4. Applications shall be submitted in the prescribed format, duly signed by the candidate, and shall be accompanied by self-attested copies of certificates in proof of educational qualifications, experience, age, community (wherever applicable) and other relevant documents.
5. No accommodation shall be provided by the Department. Further, no Travelling Allowance / Dearness Allowance (TA/DA) shall be admissible to candidates appearing for the interview or selection process.
6. If at any stage of the selection process or after engagement, it is found that the candidate has furnished false, incorrect or misleading information or has suppressed any material fact, the candidature / engagement shall be liable for cancellation forthwith, without assigning any reason or notice.
7. The engagement of the Green Fellow shall be purely temporary and contractual in nature and shall not confer any right or claim for regular appointment in the Tamil Nadu Forest Department.
8. The contractual engagement shall be for the period specified in the appointment order and may be extended or terminated at the discretion of the Department, based on project requirements and performance of the individual.
9. The remuneration shall be paid as a consolidated monthly amount as prescribed, and no other allowances, benefits or service privileges admissible to regular Government servants shall be applicable.
10. The selected Green Fellow shall be required to undertake field-based research, data collection, analysis and related duties, and perform any other work assigned by the competent authority from time to time.
11. The Tamil Nadu Forest Department reserves the right to cancel, modify, amend or withdraw this notification or the selection process, in whole or in part, at any stage, without assigning any reason thereof.
12. The decision of the competent authority in all matters relating to eligibility, selection, engagement and terms of contract shall be final and binding on all candidates.
