From the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Head of Forest Force, Chennai-15 letter No. A1/4646/2013-6, dated 19.3.2013.

ORDER:

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Head of Forest Force in his proposal has stated that according to Promotion Guidelines of Indian Forest Service Officers of various grades issued in Government of India Letter No.20019/01/ 2000-IFS.II, dated 22.12.2000, the Members of the Service, who have completed 25 years of service are eligible for consideration of their names for promotion to the post of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests. Now, upto 1988 batch officers have completed 25 years of service in Indian Forest Service. In the neighbouring State, (i.e.) in Andhra Pradesh, 1987 batch officers have been promoted as Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests. Therefore the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has requested to consider the in-situ promotion for some of the Chief Conservator of Forests as Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests subject to the condition that they may be permitted to continue to discharge the present duties and responsibilities of the post of Chief Conservator of Forests under the relevant provisions of various Acts and Rules till they are regularly promoted as Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests.

2. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has decided to give in-situ promotion to the eligible officers of 1985 batch from the level of Chief Conservator of Forests to Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests. Accordingly Government direct as follows:-

(a) 8 posts of Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, in the scale of pay of HAG Rs.67000-79000, under Rule 4(2), Proviso 2 of the Indian Forest Service (Cadre) Rules, 1966, be created as person oriented to accommodate the Chief Conservator of Forests consequent on their in situ promotion by keeping in abeyance of 8 cadre posts of Chief Conservator of Forests.

(b) The following officers be included in the panel for in-situ promotions as Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests:-

c) The above officers included in the panel be given in-situ promotion as Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests subject to the condition that they shall continue to discharge the present duties and responsibilities of the post of Chief Conservator of Forests under the relevant provisions of various Acts and Rules till they are regularly promoted as Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests.

d) The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force-Full Additional Charge) be requested to send the details of post to be kept in abeyance consequent on the above in-situ promotions.
